Day 1 – Depart on international flight from U.S. gateway

Day 2 – Arrive Edinburgh. Meet by our representative and transfer by private motorcoach to hotel. Optional afternoon round at Crail Balcomie Links.

Day 3 – Carnoustie Championship Course



The course is today much as it was in 1937, challenging golfers for nearly 70 years. Carnoustie Championship course is in the finest condition

it has ever been.

Day 4 - New Course, St Andrews



If the New Course were not next to the Old, many think its reputation would be much greater. The New Course

can be considered one of St Andrews' best kept secrets. This classic links course has, in the great St Andrews tradition, shared fairways and even a double green at the 3rd and 15th holes.

Day 5 – Kingsbarns Links



Adjacent to the ocean, Kingsbarns Golf Links is routed through interesting natural coastal terrain. This

unique part of Scotland has sandy soils, undulating ridges and hollows all set against the rugged coastline of the North Sea. This is not a layout where one can simply “hit it down the fairway”. One must consider a plan for playing here. (*Kingsbarn is the option if the New Course is not available*).

Day 6 – St. Andrews Castle Course



Opened in 2008, it's the newest in the St. Andrews Links Trust family. The Castle Course was designed by the creator of Bandon Dunes.

Its typical Scottish golf design features a choice of five tees on each hole and no handicap restrictions.

Day 7 – St. Andrews Jubilee



Originally designed for ladies and beginners, and now well into its second century of life, the Jubilee Course has developed into the toughest test of golf

at St Andrews. Located between the New Course and the ocean, the tees provide wonderful views of the links while exposing the golfers to the coastal winds.

Day 8 – Return to U.S.

EXCHANGE RATES:

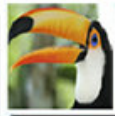
